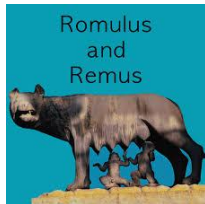

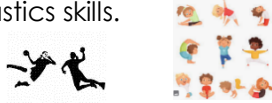
ENGLISH

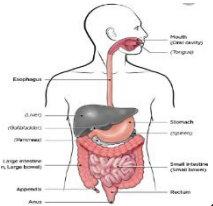
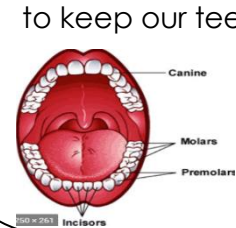
PSHCE

In PSCHCE, our focus will be on understanding Being Me in the world and how I fit in the school community. We will explore our democratic rights and empathy.



SCIENCE

Our Science focus this half term will be learning about the human digestive system and the functions of digestive organs. We will learn about the types and functions of teeth, teeth decay and how to keep our teeth clean.



Art

Our topic is storytelling through drawing. create sketch books to record our observations from story books and poems. We will learn drawing techniques using a range of materials like, pencil, charcoal, paint. We will learn about drawing styles of different illustrators.

RE

Our RE topic will be learning Ontology and is about understanding what different religion and worldviews teach about what is real and what is not.



MATHS

To begin the half-term our Maths focus will be understanding the place value of 4 digit numbers, ordering, comparing, rounding 4 digit numbers and using addition and subtraction operations to solve number problems involving 4 digits.

We will also learn our times tables to 12.



COMPUTING

We will learn about the World Wide Web.
